NOTIFICATION

R. 679. In exercise of the powers conferred by the
proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby
prescribes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment
for the post of Senior Personal Assistant in the Narcotics
Commissioner (Narcotics Department) and the Chief Controller
of Factories under the Central Board of Excise and Customs,
namely:-

Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be
called the Narcotics Commissioner (Narcotics Department) and the
Chief Controller of Factories Senior Personal Assistant Recruitment
Rules, 1990.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their
publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay. The
number of the said posts, their classification and the scale
of pay attached thereto shall be specified in the columns 2 to
4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.—
The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and
other matters connected therewith shall be specified in columns
5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualifications.— No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with
a person having a spouse living, or
(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or
contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for the appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied
that such a marriage is permissible under the personal law
applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage
and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any
person from operation of this rule.

Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

holders of the post of Stenographers Grade-I
in the revised scale of Rs.1640-2900/
Rs.1400-2300 prior to upgradation of this
post in the scale of Rs.2000-3200 will be
initially assessed for appointment to the
upgraded post. If assessed suitable he shall
be deemed to have been appointed to the post
at the initial constitution. If assessed not
suitable for appointment to the upgraded scale
of pay, he shall continue to be in the scale of
Rs.1640-2900 or Rs.1400-2300, as the case may be,
and his case would be reviewed till such officer
is found fit for holding the post in the higher
grade viz. Rs.2000-3200.
